

Glasgow TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Tuesday Jackpot

- 1. The Tuesday Jackpot tournament will run every Tuesday from 9 May 2023 at 7pm and is open to all customers.
- 2. Each entrant must register at the Poker Desk from 6.15pm prior to commencement of the tournament at 7pm, late registrations must be registered by 9.20pm.
- 3. All entrants must pay the entrance fee of £40 (£28 buy-in, £5 jackpot, £2 promotional fee and £5 registration) prior to the commencement of play.
- 4. Promotional fee contributes to the Race to Vegas promotional pot with Met Card holders earning points for the monthly leader boards.
- 5. Jackpot fee contributes to the progressive jackpot with 10% withheld as a reserve fund for the following week should the Jackpot be won.
- 6. Prior to the commencement of the tournament 25,000 starting stack of chips will be placed on the table for each paid entrant.
- 7. A starting stack of chips may be placed in a seat to accommodate late entrants (so all antes and blinds have been appropriately paid). An unsold seat will have such a stack removed at a time left to the discretion of the tournament director (usually at the end of the rebuy period).
- 8. Unlimited re-entries will be permitted for the specified late registration period of the tournament but will be relocated to another table if possible. A re-entry will need to join an existing alternate list and is not seated as a re-buy. They will be seated as close to the big blind as possible if being seated manually, or seated randomly if such a system is in place (i.e., seating cards or a digital seating system). Registration fees will apply.
- 9. All MG Poker Tournaments are governed by the Tournament Rules displayed in the Poker Room and are available on request.
- 10. 10% of the field paid in prizes, to be determined by the Tournament Director.
- 11. Completed competition guarantees a £1,000 prize pool.
- 12. All prize money will be paid out to players in cash as per the pay-out structure available from the Poker Desk.
- 13. The winner will proceed to the Jackpot selection which will be carried out as follows:
 - a. The Jackpot deck will be obtained from Cash Desk and 48 of the cards will be spread face up in suited order, the 48 cards will not include the Ace of Spades which will be added as card 49.
 - b. The Jackpot deck will be shuffled by a member of the card room using a standard casino poker shuffle and then spread face down for the winner to select six cards one at a time.
 - c. In the event of a deal, players may split the six cards under the condition that the cards are kept clear and individual for camera purposes.
 - d. The selected cards will be isolated from the remaining cards and turned over one at a time by a member of the card room team.
 - e. The Ace of Spades must be revealed within the six cards selected for the Jackpot to be won.
 - f. Once all the picks have been revealed, the remaining cards will be turned over and displayed to reveal that only one Ace of Spades card is present in the deck.
 - g. If the Ace of Spades is selected within the six picks, a full deck check will be done to ensure the Jackpot selection procedure was followed.
 - h. Should the Ace of Spades not be revealed within the six picks the Jackpot is not won and will be rolled over to the following week.
- 14. Tournament Director's decision is final.
- 15. Entry constitutes acceptance by the entrant of these terms and conditions.
- 16. Any complaints or disputes should be brought to the immediate attention of Venue Management for resolution.

- 17. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the promotion at any time. If participants have already met the qualifying criteria for the promotion, they will be entitled to participate in the promotion on the terms entered, (subject to any expiry or other conditions contained in these terms) and entitled to any benefits associated with the promotion.
- 18. Employees of the Promoter, their agents, families, or household members are prohibited from participating in this promotion.
- 19. Disregard or failure to meet any of these terms may result in the management cancelling prizes.
